

BIOGRAPHY BOOK REPORT

On March 4, we will be staging the famous "Third Grade Biography Wax Museum". This event has become something that Salem students look forward to and it's one of the first events new third graders ask about at the beginning of the year. We will be inviting everyone at Salem to join us in the gym so we can "become" our biography character.

Because of this event, our next book commercial will actually be a book report. For the report, please help your child select a biography to read. We have numerous biographies in our classroom and in the library. I have also included a list of books with RC quizzes on the back of the attached worksheet. (It is highly recommended that your child pick a biography that has a quiz.) Your child will also need to prepare a display board representing his/her biography subject. On the board, include the subject's name in large letters and any other information that is interesting about your child's biography subject.

The following will be the grading rubric for the biography book report:

- You introduced the person you read about.
- You told why you chose that person for your report.
- You told when the person was born.
- If the person has died you told the date of death.
- You told at least five things that happened in the person's life.
- You told two reasons why he/she is an important person.
- You filled out the attached worksheet including five interesting things about your person.
- You created a display board to be used at the wax museum that introduces your person to an audience.
- You spoke loudly and clearly.
- You told your opinion of the book.
